When Lucy was growing up on the streets of Chicago, she never could have imagined that one day she would travel the world as an international popstar. Now, a world-renowned star in her mid-thirties, she finds herself headlining- and settling down - at a major hotel in Las Vegas. While she battles her own demons and insecurities, Lucy's life is complicated by the sudden arrival of Sunny, her teenage daughter, whom she hardly knows.

As Sunny and Lucy struggle to build a relationship, Sunny finds that her mom is a package deal - she comes with an extensive posse or, as Sunny dubs them, the "momtourage."

The momtourage is ever-present and makes up much of the fabric of Lucy's life. Now, they become part of Sunny's life as well - which is at times both annoying and comforting to an adolescent girl. While there to cater to every whim, they also make sure that Lucy stays grounded and doesn't forget from where she came. The momtourage includes Lucy's personal assistant, her stylist, her hair and makeup person, her personal chef, her personal trainer, and most importantly, her best friend, Cicely. Other people in her orbit include her ex-husband, Ted, who re-enters her life as they struggle to find a way to co-parent Sunny; and her mom, Ronnie, who seems to be developing a bit of a gambling problem.

Momtourage, a comedy-drama that, while taking an inside look at the world of celebrity and pop music, actually uncovers some of the underlying pain and insecurity of that world and tells the story of how two strangers - a mother and a daughter - learn to find a place in each other's hearts.
