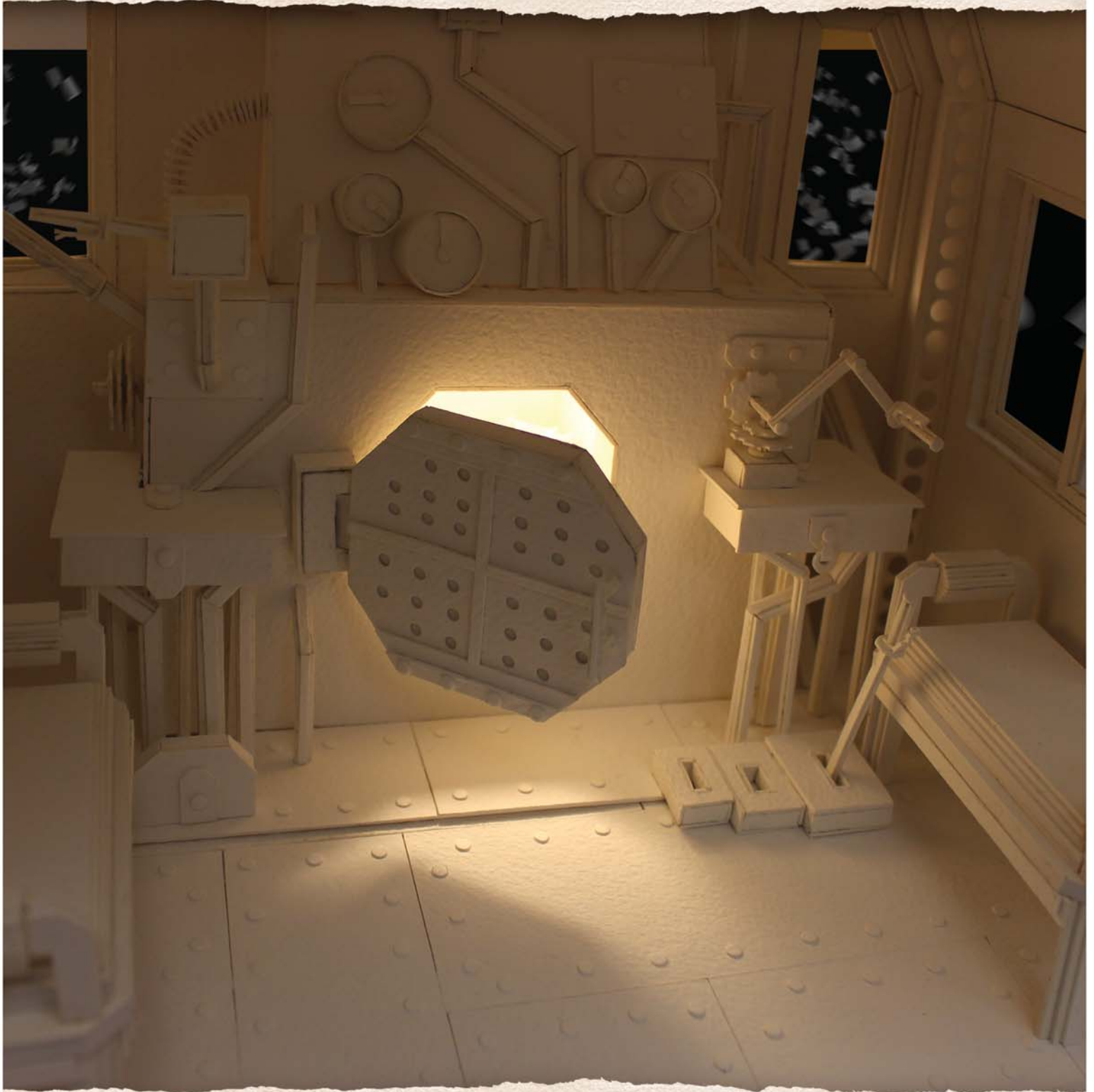

Jamie's Paper Train is an award winning short film which tugs at the heart strings in all of us. Inspired by the real life story of a young boy with autism, Jamie's Paper Train is a visual metaphor for the challenges that face those affected by the condition.



Autism is a disorder that affects tens of millions of people globally (1 in 68), and is characterized by trouble with social interaction and communication. It occurs four-to-five times more often in boys than in girls and is just now being brought out of the shadows to become part of the global child development conversation.

Seeking comfort in a world of overstimulation, Jamie finds escape through his passion for making paper trains. With the love and support of his parents, Jamie spends endless hours, embracing his imagination and forging bonds with those with whom he struggles to make real world connections.



This powerful but sensitive film, entirely produced by renowned Canadian studio PIP Animation, combines various animation techniques including stop motion as well as 2D and 3D. It is told through the music of Jack Noble's unmistakable Canadian maritime charm.

A film for all ages, Jamie's Paper Train seeks to bring to the world's attention this difficult but all too common disability. Worldwide rights are available for this endearing short film.
